

World Tricycle Championship Weekend

Social Programme

St Marsault, Deux Sèvres, France 18th – 21st June 2009

The Campsite on the Sports field will be available from Thursday 17th until Monday 22nd. It is situated on the D938 halfway between La Foret and St Marsault. It is provided free but a donation of 5 Euros per pitch to the Fete Committee funds would be appreciated. There are showers and loos and some electric hook-ups. Bring your own toilet rolls.

Nothing definite is planned for Thursday evening but usually some people go to Janette's at La Foret for an evening meal.

NB If cycling after dark in France it is now compulsory to wear a High Visibility Vest complying to EN471.

Friday 19th

Evening meal at La Table Ronde 7pm. Price 15 Euros per person. The village of La Ronde is on the new Time Trial course and is only a few kilometres south of St Marsault.

Saturday 20th

3pm; World Tricycle Championship event starts. Registration from 2pm. The new start is in the village of St Marsault on the road from the bar towards La Ronde about 300m beyond the church. The finish is as before.

The presentation of awards will follow immediately after the Event on the Fete ground near the finish.

7pm; Evening meal at the Restaurant de la Sevre (Janette's) in La Foret. Price 15 Euros per person.

Sunday 21st

10am Clubrun leaving from the Sports field to arrive at ChezJB Restaurant, St Pierre du Chemin for lunch at 12.30. Cost of lunch without drinks is 10 Euros per person.

There are other activities arranged by the Fete Committee such as country walks and mountain bike rides. The fair itself is usually open from lunchtime.

Sunday evening The Fete dinner (Repas). Tickets are very reasonably priced and can be purchased from the Bar in St Marsault over the weekend. The evening is the highlight of the weekend for the village and is accompanied by musicians singing typically French folk songs. Wine is available on the evening (also very reasonably priced).
